Women's and Girl's Rodeo Rules and Regulations

- The fishing will start at 6AM on 7/17/26 and end at 6:00PM on 7/18/26.
- Weigh-in will be 7/17/26 @ 2pm-6pm and 7/18/26 @ 2pm-6pm.
- Each paid angler must present an ID badge before weighing and may weigh in one fish per category. Each badge will represent the category and captain of the angler.
- All fish categories will be weighed in pounds. In the event of a tie, fish weighed in first will win.
- All decisions by weighmaster are final
- Anglers must abide by LDWF size and bag limits
- No male anglers will be allowed to aid in catching.
- Men may Captain, bait hooks, net fish and remove fish from hook

Captains Note:

Weigh-in will be at the Coco Marina, boats may pull in along the dock to unload and weigh in fish. Upon weigh-in completion you may pull your boat forward and pull out please. Please help us try to avoid congestion.

Top Captain's Award

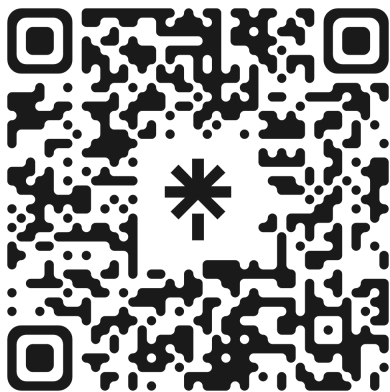
This award is based on a point system. All divisions will have equal points. The captain with the most points wins!

1st Place Fish	200 Points
2nd Place Fish	100 Points
3rd Place Fish	50 Points

Youth Category is any girl of the age of 2 to 16 years old at the time of the tournament. Women Category is any woman at the age of 17 and older at the time of the tournament.
